Transnational Judicial Communication and the Techniques of Legal Interpretation: A Crucial Liaison?

Looking at Art. 1 of the Swiss Civil Code with a Comparative Lens

Art. 1 of the Swiss Civil Code (SCC) has been depicted as one of the main gateways for comparative law in Switzerland. It also represents a powerful instrument with respect to transnational judicial communication, namely the voluntary use that Swiss judges make of foreign case law when adjudicating purely domestic cases. With the aim of securing a deeper understanding of the central and propulsive role Art. 1 SCC can potentially play in this field, this informal discussion will provide a comparative analysis of a number of foreign provisions concerning interpretative legal techniques, namely those of Austria, Italy, France, and Germany.
